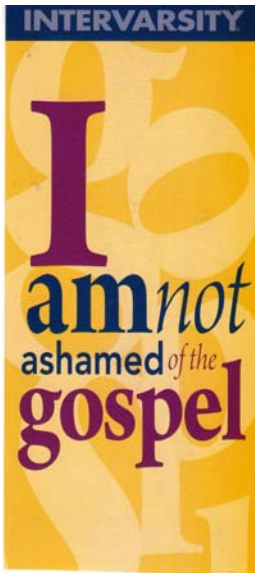


A Living Hope

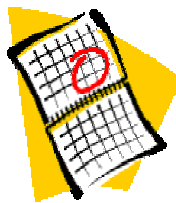
